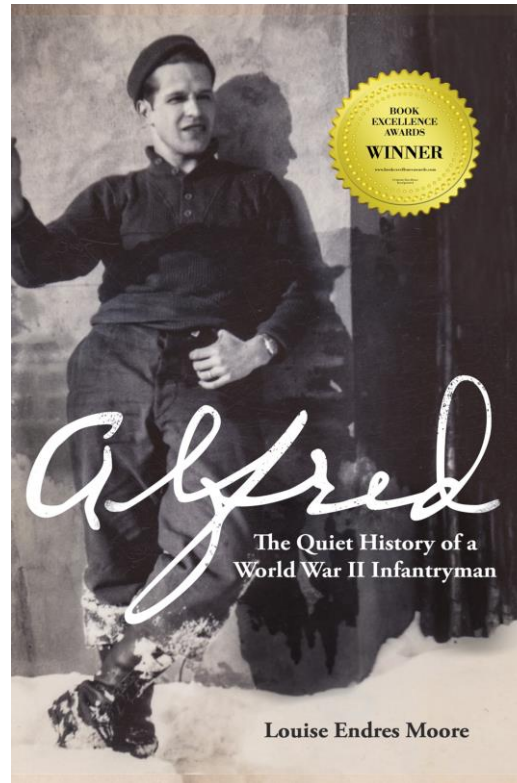
In this 80th Anniversary year of D-Day, BHC is pleased to offer these important historical accounts of heroic WWII service.
